

# The Weekly Wave



We hope everyone is doing well. As we prepare to return to an in-person hybrid learning model, it is important that you understand the hybrid plan and next week's schedule.

If you opted for in-person learning, you will soon be assigned a group (Group A or Group B) based alphabetically by your last name. **The first week of school (January 19th-22nd) will look different than the following weeks so we may orient our 6th grade students to the building. Please review the [School Calendar January 18th-29th](#) to know when you should be in school or when you should be at home distance learning.** The calendar for the next two weeks of school is also located on the second page of this newsletter.

Students who opted for in-person learning will attend school for two days a week. In-person students are to follow their 7 period schedule and attend google meets for classes when they are not in school. For example, a student assigned to Group A will attend in-person learning on Tuesday and Thursday. On Wednesday and Friday, Group A students will attend their classes by google meets at home. The opposite applies for students assigned to Group B. *Students must bring their charged Chromebook to school on their assigned in-person learning days.*

Students who opted for Distance Learning are expected to attend all of their classes starting on January 19<sup>th</sup> through google meets following the 7 period schedule that starts promptly at 8am (Tuesday-Friday) from home. The students' school day will end at 2:25pm.

If you **did not** submit a response to the survey, it is assumed that your child/student will remain in full Distance Learning until the next opt-in period.
